Purpose

The purpose of this document is to describe the network connectivity requirements for the NRP Learning Platform.

NRP Curricula

The NRP curricula is broken into two portions: Cognitive and Skills.

Cognitive

The Cognitive portion consists of browser based, self-paced learning via an internet connected device.

Skills

The learner attends an Instructor Led Event (ILE).

Type of Access

Retail Portal

Access to the NRP LP via the Retail Portal allows an individual to utilize the e-commerce module to purchase NRP courses directly in the NRP LP.

Organization Subdomain

Organizations that proceed with an implementation, such as Enterprise or 3rd Party LMS implementations, are given an organization-specific subdomain to access the NRP LP. Access to the NRP LP via a Subdomain will disable the e-commerce module, thereby preventing users / admins from making purchases directly in the NRP LP.
